

St. Joseph the Provider School enrolls students in Grades K-8 and has an enrollment of 133 students. Our students benefit from small class sizes. Of our students, 100% are entitled to free or reduced breakfast and lunch.

The St. Joseph the Provider School year is divided into four quarters of nine weeks, each with a mid-quarter interim report and a nine week end of quarter report. Our school year is comprised of 178 days of instruction and two parent-teacher conference days. Our school day is from 7:20 a.m. until 2:15 p.m.
